Pursuant to Article VI of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainant has filed a petition for review of the order of the Chief Judge entered September 11, 2024, dismissing the complaints against a circuit judge, two district judges, and two magistrate judges of this circuit.¹

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the Chief Judge in the order of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for overturning the order of dismissal.

For the reasons stated by the Chief Judge and based upon the controlling authority cited in support thereof, we affirm.
