Pursuant to Article VI of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainant has filed a petition for review of the orders of the Chief Judge entered November 21, 2024, dismissing the complaints against five district judges of this circuit.

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the Chief Judge in her order of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for overturning the order of dismissal.
