Pursuant to Article VI of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-
Disability Proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 352(c), complainant has filed a
petition for review of the order of the circuit judge entered November 29, 2024,
dismissing the complaint against the chief circuit judge.¹

We have carefully reviewed the record and the authorities cited by the
circuit judge in the order of dismissal. We conclude there is no basis for
overturning the order of dismissal.

For the reasons stated by the circuit and based upon the controlling
